Scholar Handbook Highlights

Dress Code

Tops

- Plain navy blue, gray, black or white shirt
- Paul Revere logo shirt
- Must have sleeves, a modest neckline and be waist length
- No graphics or logos
- Undershirts must be solid navy, gray, black or white

Bottoms

- Must be a solid color blue, khaki, gray or black
- Jeans, cargo pants and shorts are okay
- Clean, no holes or distressing
- Fitted and worn at the waist
- No pajamas or leggings (worn as pants)
- Shorts no shorter than 4" above the middle of the kneecap
- Skirts must be knee length when sitting or standing

Shoes

- No slippers
- Open-toed shoes are okay
- Must have a back strap/support
- Laces must be tied

Outerwear

- Solid Navy, Gray, Black or White in color
- No logos or graphics
- No dark glasses or hats in the building

Grooming

- Hair must be a naturally occurring color
- Simple makeup and jewelry
- No body piercings or gauged ears
- No extreme haircuts
- Maintain a neat and clean appearance

Students must follow EVIT's dress code when attending CTE classes.

Attendance

- Classes are Monday through Thursday
- No school on Fridays (unless stated otherwise)
- No half days, late start or early release days
- 1st Period starts at 8am
- 9th Period ends at 3:45pm
- Classes are 55 minutes long
- 9th Grade end time is 2:43pm (after 8th period)
- On time means being appropriately seated in class when the bell rings
- Any scholar who is absent 10% or more (about 7 absences) per semester may not receive credit for the class.

Academics

- Teachers update grades via Powerschool weekly
- Scholars must earn a 60% or above to pass a class
- Grades are awarded on a semester basis
- Dual Enrollment classes available

Extra-Curricular

- Scholar must be passing classes to participate in extra-curriculars
- We have an on-campus scholar council
- Campus events and celebrations are regularly hosted and scholar organized
- Scholars may organize clubs with approval from administration
- After school sports available through Heritage Academy network of schools
